The Collegiate World Series (11th grade)

What is the CWS?

The CWS is a 5-day residential leadership program for bright 11th grade students who are getting ready to apply to college. The CWS is a two-part program that is meant to work on a student's analytical skills. It seeks to prepare a student for the college admissions process and the important decisions associated with making the switch into adulthood. The CWS is hosted at three sites across the country and abroad.

Where does the LDZ take place?

Jefferson Dental applicants can apply to one of the two below:

The Texas CWS in Denton, Texas, hosted at the University of North Texas. **Dates: July 26-30, 2017** The Northeast CWS in Radnor, Pennsylvania hosted at Cabrini University. **Dates: July 19-23, 2017**

How much is the CWS?

The cost is \$625. This fee covers all of a student's meals, stay at the university dormitories and materials while at the program. There is an added fee of \$45 for transportation.

What are the requirements to join the CWS?

Students who wish to gain acceptance to the CWS must meet a MINIMUM 3.2 GPA and must apply within the deadline to avoid being placed on a waitlist.

Timeline:

- Deadline to apply us March 1st
- Students have 10 days FROM DAY OF ACCEPTANCE to pay \$170 (\$20 application fee and \$170 deposit) to activate JDC scholarship of 50%.
- Students have 30 days to pay remaining balance or set up a payment plan with NHI office.

Capacity:

There are a select number of spots available in each program. If a program fills up, a student would instead be placed to a waitlist or be transferred into a similar program. Students who have submitted a deposit for the program receive preference than students who have not.

Houston and HISD Scholarship:

Students in Houston who attend a public high school within the HISD are eligible to receive an additional scholarship from the district.

Payments:

All payments must be made to the National Hispanic Institute by:
